Re: Game Procedures for Officials and Timekeepers
To: ALLIANCE Hockey Officials and Timekeepers

Due to an unprecedented hockey season and limited ice availability, it is important that officials assist with keeping games on time and completed in the allotted time frame.

- Please be ready for the scheduled game start time
- Work with bench staff to reduce the down time between the warm up and break

For all ALLIANCE Hockey game play, it is important that a game sheet is present and properly completed.

On-ice Official:

- Officials are required to inform all goals and penalties to the timekeeper

Timekeepers:

- Timekeepers should always be aware of the referees during the game to assist with communication of penalties and goals

NOTE: Timekeepers should not have any personal electronic devices out during their game assignments
