Name of Team: Waterloo Wolves Midget AAA

The Midget AAA Waterloo Wolves are a regional, provincial and national success story. Since their inaugural season in 2002-2003, the Wolves have played 690 regular season, playoff and tournament games. The team has compiled an impressive record of 465 wins, 176 losses and 42 ties—a winning percentage of .704. The Wolves have been to the National Championship, Provincial Regionals and the ALLIANCE Hockey Championship.

Facility: Pillers Pad, Rim Park, Waterloo, Ontario

The arena has seating for 300 people with glass viewing both above and at ice level.

Home Games: Monday Nights, 7:30pm

Practice Times: Practices are held on Tuesdays from 5:00pm-7:00pm, usually with a 1-hour dry land component following and on Thursday nights 7:30pm-9:00pm

Cost: The total cost to our players after WMHA registration is \$1500.00. All of the below mentioned benefits are included in the Team fee. As well all player travel expenses are paid, on the big trip/tournament, including hotel, travel, and a per diem food allowance for the duration of the trip.

Dressing Room and Amenities: The Wolves enjoy the use of their own dressing room which includes, coaches room, trainers area and storage.

- -The player's room has full washroom and shower facilities
- -Each player has his own stall for personal equipment with storage above and below
- -The dressing room has an LCD tv, DVD player and Stereo
- -The coaches use projection TV for game video review
- -The players are supplied with bags, warm up suits, t-shirts, shorts, dress shirts, leather jackets
- -The Wolves travel by bus for all "road games" and tournaments.
- -The players hockey sticks are supplied at a discount
- -Hockey skate sharpening is provided with the team's own sharpener

Trips and Tournaments: The Wolves participate in 5 tournaments and or trips per season.

Tournaments have included:

- -London Green and Gold , Ottawa Senators, Kitchener Blueline , Waterloo Gold Puck , Drummondville International, Toronto Titans, Kelowna International.
- -The Wolves are going to Kelowna, BC in 2013-2104.
- -The Wolves have been to **Europe** twice in the last 5 years.

The team record for the 2012-2013 season consisted of—34 wins, 29 regulation-time losses, 2 overtime losses, and 2 shootout losses.
