Subject: Arena Spectator Update

Dear Arena Users,

With public health and health care indicators stable and proof of vaccination now in effect, the Provincial Government is cautiously easing capacity limits for select indoor and outdoor settings where proof of vaccination is required.

Effective immediately:

- Capacity limits will be lifted to allow 100 per cent capacity for spectators in designated viewing areas such as bleachers
- Other areas in the facility such as hallways outside pools, gyms and arenas are remaining at 50% capacity
- Limited capacities remain in place for dressing rooms and changerooms
- Based on participant feedback, entrance to the facility has been increased to 30 minutes prior to your program start. Please be aware of lobby capacities. If lobbies become overcrowded, staff will reserve the right to ask you to leave.
- Other public health and workplace safety measures continue to remain in effect:
 - Complete City of Burlington [screening](#)
 - Wearing face coverings
 - Showing proof of vaccination
 - Maintain two meters of physical distancing
